Pre-Event Information

On arrival please report to the stand at trackside for 9am.

This event will operate under UKA Rules effective 1st April 2020, officials should also be aware of Safe Athletics Track & Field Safety Guide for Competition.

Car Parking

Parking is available on a first come first served basis within the stadium Car Park

Event Day Information

Opentrack will be in operation.

Call Room and Assembly Area

Field: athletes will report directly to the event area. Officials should be in place as soon as possible to allow for multiple warm up trials to be conducted.

Field Events

All horizontal jumps will be held WITH the prevailing wind.

All athletes will receive 6 trials (except HJ/PV), no reversal after round 3.

Triple Jump - Board and Run-Up Restrictions 7m, 9m, 11m boards will be in operation. U15 athletes will be permitted a maximum run up of **22m**.

High Jump

Start Heights to be agreed with the athletes

5cm Increments until 3 athletes remain, thereafter minimum of 2cm

Pole Vault

Start Height - 2.00m

10cm Increments until 3 athletes remain, thereafter minimum of 5cm

All events will start promptly at the advertised time. Ahletes will be allowed as many warm up attempts as they chose in advance of the start time.

Refreshments

Due to covid restrictions, officials are asked to bring their own refreshments for the day and sun cream if the weather is nice

COVID Guidelines

- Please check in with Susan Millar who marked you off on the attendance sheet for the purposes of track and trace
- Sanitise any equipment you are using before and after each event
- Try to stay socially distanced from each other (e.g. minimum of 2m). If at any time you are unable to maintain social distance or require to use the indoor facilities e.g. toilets please wear your mask
- Toilet facilities are inside the centre
- Officials are asked to sanitise the pit or the HJ/PV mats before and after each event
- For High Jump and Pole Vault please wipe the bar each time it is knocked off the pegs.

Chief judge on each event to allocate the duties and will act as the referee for that event, however if you would like experience in a particular duty please speak to your chief judge.
