Medals

Individual medals: 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category (U13, U15, U17, U20, Senior, Master 40+), plus 1st only Master 50+.

Bib Numbers: U17 athletes will wear RED numbers. Masters V40 athletes will wear a V on the FRONT and BACK of their vests, with Masters V50 wearing an X on the FRONT and BACK of their vests.

Team medals: 1st, 2nd and 3rd with 3 to count, except Senior Men (6 to count) and Senior Women (4 to count), plus 1st only Masters Team (3 to count).

The Senior, Masters 40+ and Masters 50+ races are combined for each gender.

All athletes may count in the Senior Championship race (individual and team) as well as their own age category, therefore a Masters athlete can count in both the Senior AND Masters individual and team races. However, a Masters athlete cannot compete in both the 40+ and 50+ individual championships; only their own age category.

In scoring the Masters team placings, only Masters athletes are considered.

Prizegiving

Medals will be presented near the Start/Finish area as soon as possible after each race, or inside the AAA area depending on the weather. Note that there can sometimes be delays in processing /calculating results so please be patient and respectful of the work that the volunteers are doing. Medals can be posted on if necessary.

AAA Access

Please remove muddy shoes before entering the indoor track area

Declarations

Declarations are open from 1030 in the indoor track. Team managers only please. Course maps and race details will be available at Declaration and in the foyer.

Changing

There are 6 male and 3 female changing rooms, each equipped with multiple showers (except disabled changing rooms -which are **available** to be used, but have only 1 shower). There is additional male changing in the curtained area at the end of the indoor track.

Toilets

There are toilet facilities in the changing rooms and in the main toilets within the AAA which is within 100m of the Start.

Course

The course consists of a mixture of parkland, riverside path and farmer's fields (normally used for livestock). On the blue and red laps there is a 30 metre section of rough road.

The course will be marked with tape - red and white tape on the right boundary, black and yellow on the left.

First Aid

First Aid will be located near the Start/Finish area.

Warming-up / Course Access

Please keep clear of the football pitches. To gain access to the Start / Finish and Team Tent area, you are required to cross the course. Please stay within markers and watch out for runners.

Club Tents

There is ample space for club tents near the Start/Finish area. Please assemble tents behind the barriers in the finish straight looking on to the course to ensure maximum support for the athletes. Please pay attention to the Tent and Gazebo guidelines on the Event Website

Catering

Hot soup and home baking will be available in the General Purposes Room of the AAA. A catering van providing a range of hot and cold food will be outside the AAA main building.

Directions

Travelling south on the M77/A77 take the 3rd exit for Kilmarnock. The AAA is close to the major intersection between the A77, A76, A71 and A735. Follow the signs for the A735 / Town Centre to reach the AAA.

Parking

Parking at the AAA is for officials only. Please follow map and directions below for Competitor Parking. This is adjacent to the course and is within 200 metres of the AAA



Competitor Parking

- The AAA is close to the major intersection between the M(A)77, A71 and A76. Follow the signs for A735/Town Centre.
- Limited Parking at the AAA / Follow map and directions below for Competitor Parking. Diversion signs will be in place.
- From the Ayrshire Athletics Arena, continue on Queen's Drive/A735 for 0.1 miles (yellow dotted line) and at first roundabout take the second exit. Continue for 0.2 miles and at roundabout take the second exit.
- Move into outside lane and turn right at the traffic lights onto Newmill Road.
- Continue for 0.3 miles and competitor car park is on the right.
