

# scottishathletics Inter District Cross Country Championships 2023 incorporating British Athletics Cross Challenge Scone Palace Parklands, Scone, Perth Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2023

### PARKING

Officials Parking only will be permitted within the parklands. All other vehicles must park at Scone Race Course (PH2 6BG) Please park responsibly and follow instructions from parking stewards. A parking map is available to download form the event fixture page.

### SCONE PALACE LIVESTOCK

There will be free roaming sheep within the parklands during this event. Therefore, please **DO NOT** bring any dogs to this event.

### **TENTS/GAZEBOS**

Vehicles with tents and gazebos will be allowed to drop these off at the entrance to the Parklands and then must return to the race course parking area. Clubs who plan to bring a tent must apply for a tent drop-off permit by emailing <u>events@scottishathletics.org.uk</u> before 12 noon on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2023. Permits are strictly 1 per club and are only for cars dropping off tents or gazebos.

### DECLARATIONS

Declarations will take place in marquee within the parklands. Declarations will be open from 09:30 for athletes and team managers to pick up bib numbers. Numbers should be securely fastened to the front of the vest.

Under 20 athletes in the 6km race will be given a number for their front and an age banding (20) for their back.

# FACILITIES

*Changing:* There will be <u>NO</u> changing or shower facilities available. Please come ready to run. *Toilets:* There are toilet facilities available at the entrance to the parklands. *Catering:* Available from a catering van, also near the entrance to the parklands. Please remember to dispose of all litter correctly.

#### PRESENTATIONS

Individual presentations will take place immediately after each race at the course. Inter District team medals will be collected by team managers for distribution to their District teams. In all Inter District races, teams are 6 to score. There are no team awards in the Cross Challenge races.
