GENERAL

Gordonstoun School has asked all attendees to be aware of the following:

- school activities will be in progress at Gordonstoun School throughout the day so please be respectful towards the pupils and staff.

- Please note the speed limit at Gordonstoun is 10mph.

- No parking near boarding houses or on grass verges.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ENTRY AND EXIT IS NOW THROUGH THE EAST GATE ONLY. PLEASE DO NOT TRY AND ENTER VIA THE DUFFUS ENTRANCE.

From Inverness (approximate journey time 1 hour)


Take the B861 from Inverness aiming for the A96 signposted Nairn, Forres and Elgin. Following the A96 past the airport turn-off, through Nairn and the outskirts of Forres until you reach Elgin and the Eight Acres Hotel.

From Elgin (approximate journey time 10 minutes).

At the Eight Acres Hotel on the outskirts of Elgin turn left (right if approaching from the Aberdeen direction) and follow the road for one mile before turning left onto the B9012 signposted Hopeman. Proceed for four miles until you reach the village of Duffus. The Post Office and Duffus Inn will appear in front of you as the road bends to the left. **DO NOT TURN RIGHT** into Gordonstoun Road. Continue to the T-Junction and turn right along the B9040 then right again. East Gate is on your right indicated on the map below. Proceed to the Sports Centre Car Park which is a short drive on the left hand side.

Car Parking is available at the Sports Centre with limited parking available elsewhere on site if required. Please car share wherever possible and follow marshalling instructions.

Registration Packs will be available in the Sports Centre foyer.

There will be external toilets (portaloos) and no changing facilities in order to minimise congestion within the Sports Centre and deconflict with school sporting fixtures. Please come prepared for adverse weather conditions.

Refreshments will be available in the Sports Centre foyer.

First Aid cover will be provided by Event First Aid Service (Scotland).

Prizegiving for junior races will take place near the finish area as soon as results have been collated. Senior prizegiving will take place in the Sports Centre foyer.
