Important Notes						
(1) Races are open to Senior and Junior Men and Women born before 31st August 2007						
i.e. No Under 17 Men or Women						
(2) Mactars Teams, Mastars Age Group from 40 for both Man and Waman, age on day. Also models for Te						

(2) Masters Teams - Masters Age Group from 40 for both Men and Women – age on day. Also medals for Teams of M50 (4 legs) and W50 (3 legs)

(3) Athletes can only run once, any team with an athlete running a second time will be removed from the results.

(4) Athletes who compete in an SAL championship MUST be current members of the Scottish Athletics Membership Scheme as Per UKA Rule G2. Furthermore, an entered athlete MUST not be substituted by a non-entered athlete at any time.

(5) Athletes can only enter for their 1st Claim Scottish Club, athletes cannot be entered for their 2nd claim club.

(6) All competitors MUST compete in their declared order, and club colours must be worn.

(7) Students in Full-time Education in Scotland

Students in full-time education in Scotland may compete as 1st claim for both their educational establishment and another Scottish club but not in the same competition. This is provided that the educational establishment Club is confined to students of that establishment. Thus a student may be entered for two clubs but has to choose one at declaration.

(8) Club Affiliation fees must have been paid.

(9) Further information, including Location Map and Course Map, will be available at www.scottishathletics.org.uk

(10) By entering all athletes agree that photographs and/or video footage may be taken and used for PR/Marketing purposes.

(11) Club entries must ensure that entrants are medically fit to compete, have no medical issues or disability that would endanger themselves or others by taking part (and will not run if unfit to do so on the day).
