a) There will be set start heights and progressions for each Meet. Where entry numbers are lower than expected adaptions to the

- b) Competitions will be held under UKA Rules and is a scottishathletics permitted event
- c) Competition bibs will be allocated to athletes for the Sky High Series. Where an athlete looses a bib there will be a replacement bib allocated at a cost of £2.00 per bib.
- d) There will be two results produced.
 - Result One As per normal rules of scoring competitions and forwarded to SATS, Po10 etc.
 - Result Two For the Sky High Grand Prix, Indoor Competition (SHGPIC), athletes will be allocated with a Sky High Handicap which will be used to re-score each meet after the official scoring has taken place. See Sky High details below. Athletes participating in the Debutant/Espoirs Competition will be scored in the Sky High Grand Prix scoring.
- e) Entries will be on a first come first served basis and PB's will be confirmed through Power of 10.
- f) Entries to SHGPIC will be limited to a maximum of 16 athletes and there will be two pools announced two days before each Meet. Pool A (lower start height) will begin competition at 10:30am. Pool B (higher start height) will begin competition no later than 1pm
- g) Warm-ups will begin at 09:30 for Pool A and not before 11:30am for Pool B. If there is not two Pools for the SHGPIC this will be announced two days before the competition.
- h) Entries to Debutant and Espoirs Competitons will be limited to 8 athletes, with one Pool
- i) Athletes should supply their own poles. There will be limited poles available at the venues which can be hired from Glasgow Pole Vault School for a flat fee of £10.00 per meet. Should an athletes break a hired pole, they will need to replace the pole as per normal pole vault convention with a pole from the same manufacture and of length, weight and flex as the broken pole.
- j) There will be a designated coaches area at each Meet, with a seperate spectator zone.
- k) DEFINITIONS
 - BEGINER COMPETITOR IN THEIR FIRST OR SECOND YEAR OF COMPETITION.
 - > ESPOIR COMPETITOR WITH A RANGE OF COMPETITION EXPERIENCES GREATER THAN TWO YEARS. AND HAS A PB OF 4.00M OR LESS ON 30 NOVEMBER 2021.
 - OVER 18 IS A COMPETITOR AGED 18 YEARS OF AGE (AND OLDER) ON 31 DECEMBER 2021.
 - > COMPETITORS WILL ONLT BE ENTITLED TO WIN ONE TROPHY/PRIZE.
 - PRIZE MONIES WILL BE AWARDED AS (i) AN OVER 18 PRIZE OR (ii) AN UNDER 18 PRIZE. WHERE PRIZE MONEY IS INDICATED THE HIGHER AMOUNT WILL BE THE OVER 18 MONETRY PRIZE.

SKY HIGH INDOORS POLE VAULT - Grand Prix Information

i) NO refunds on entry fees.

- Athletes will be allocated a handicap before each meet. The handicap will be related to the Scottish National Record height of 5.65m and the athletes personal best height according to the Po10 most current lists Athletes with no previous heights will be allocated an initial handicap of +2.00m.
- iii) The allocated handicap will be added to the athletes competition height.
- iv) The combined heights for each athlete (competition height + handicap) will be used to re-score the Event.
- v) Points will be allocated to each athlete based on the result of the re-scored event.

Position 1 after re-score. 100 SH Points
Position 2 after re-score. 99 SH Points
Position 3 after re-score. 98 SH Points

Position 16 after re-score. 85 SH Points

Pole Vaulters ENTERED WHO WITHDRAW AFTER WARM-UP FINISHES in any Meet will be scored 60 points for that Meet. Pole Vaulters ENTERED BUT NOT DECLARING TO COMPETE in any Meet will be scored 40 points for that Meet.

Pole Vaulters not ENTERING in any Meet will be scored NIL points for that Meet.

- vi) After each SHGPIC Meet, handicaps will be reviewed and where necessary, handicaps will be re-allocated.
- vii) In deciding the overall SKY HIGH INDOOR Champion; the THREE highest SH Points allocated to each athlete, from the SKY HIGH Series will be totalled, giving each athlete an overall points total. The athlete with the highest points total will be Grand Prix Champion.
- viii) WHERE POINTS TOTALS ARE SHARED, PLACES WILL BE DECIDED BY THE GREATER NUMBEROF HIGH SCORES. EG A pole vaulter with two scores of 100 SH Points will be places higher than an athlete with one score of 100 SH points.
- ix) The Glasgow Pole Vault Grand Prix Coaches Award will be decided by the Glasgow Pole Vault School.
